MINUTES OF THE GENERAL MEETING September 9, 2013, 7:30, Cammidge House, Delta, B. C.

Elizabeth Perrin moved, seconded by Jennifer Melville-Roberts, for **approval of the Minutes of June 10**, **2013 General Meeting** (as published in the Newsletter). Passed. These were denied in Ferndale, WA, where the proposal was to boost the night broadcast from 10,000 to 50,000 watts. These towers are aimed at Canada, as the station's focus market is on an ethnic the South Asian population in BC.
