## **Comments:**

- Jim Ronback cautioned that, with the present cold weather, **hummingbird feeders** may be freezing. He suggested (a) "sweetening" the mix, (b) installing insulation and a 1 watt LED light.
- Tom Bearrss reported that the **Barn Owl Box** (mansion?) is expected to be installed on the 18<sup>th</sup> at 10:30 and a trail shall be made to access this box which has an elaborate raising/lowering system. The "other" barn owl box has been installed in the North 40.
- Tom Bearss advised that the **Boundary Bay restoration** ongoing project is presently seeing designated dune walk paths installed.
- RAPP (report all poachers and polluters) is where any wildlife harassment should be reported; i.e., snowy owls

**Sightings**: Red Breasted Sapsuckers, Kestrels, Tundra Swans, Long-eared and short-eared owls, snowy owls.
